

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AS OF THE 11<sup>TH</sup> OF OCTOBER 2021**

Any persons entering these premises agrees to comply with the following "Conditions of Entry", which have been implemented in accordance with the current NSW Public Health (Covid-19) Order relating to this premises for the purpose of keeping patrons and staff safe:

1. Only fully vaccinated persons over the age of 16 years of age will be permitted to enter the premises. *Children under the age of 16 years of age will be permitted however they must be accompanied by a vaccinated parent/s or guardian*

**Valid forms of evidence are:**

- **A COVID-19 digital certificate, and**
- **An immunisation history statement**

**People may access these documents through the Medicare Express Plus mobile app or with a Medicare online account (through myGov)**

**Patrons may also use their Apple Digital Wallet or Google Pay to show their vaccination certificate**

**Any members or guests who cannot show proof of vaccination will not be permitted under any circumstances onto the premises**

**Any person who breaches the vaccination requirements or uses fraudulent evidence of vaccination or check in may receive an on-the-spot fine of \$1,000. Clubs retain their existing powers under common law and the *Liquor Act* to turn away any patron, including those who are argumentative or quarrelsome**

2. Members and guests must then provide personal contact details via the service NSW QR code. Members and guests must then sign in using the Club's sign in system
3. Every person in an indoor area of the club must wear a mask which fits securely around their nose and mouth. Masks may be removed to eat or drink
4. Some people are exempt from wearing a mask if they have a condition, illness, or disability such as autism or trauma. People who are exempt must carry evidence including a certificate from a practitioner or NDIS provider, or a statutory declaration

5. The 4 square meter rule will apply within indoor areas. The outdoor terrace areas are subject to the 2 square meter rule
6. Bookings for people up to 20 permitted only within the restaurant
7. Members and visitors are always required to follow the direction of club management
8. Be refused entry if they display signs of illness
9. Be requested to leave should they display signs of illness after entry
10. Adhere to social distancing as required including at entry and exit points or where markings are in place
11. Comply with any request to relocate due to patron number restrictions in any area

Failure to comply with any or all these conditions may constitute an offence under the Public Health Order and the licensee, their staff or agents reserve the right to remove from the premises any patron not adhering to these conditions under Section 77 of the Liquor Act 2007.
